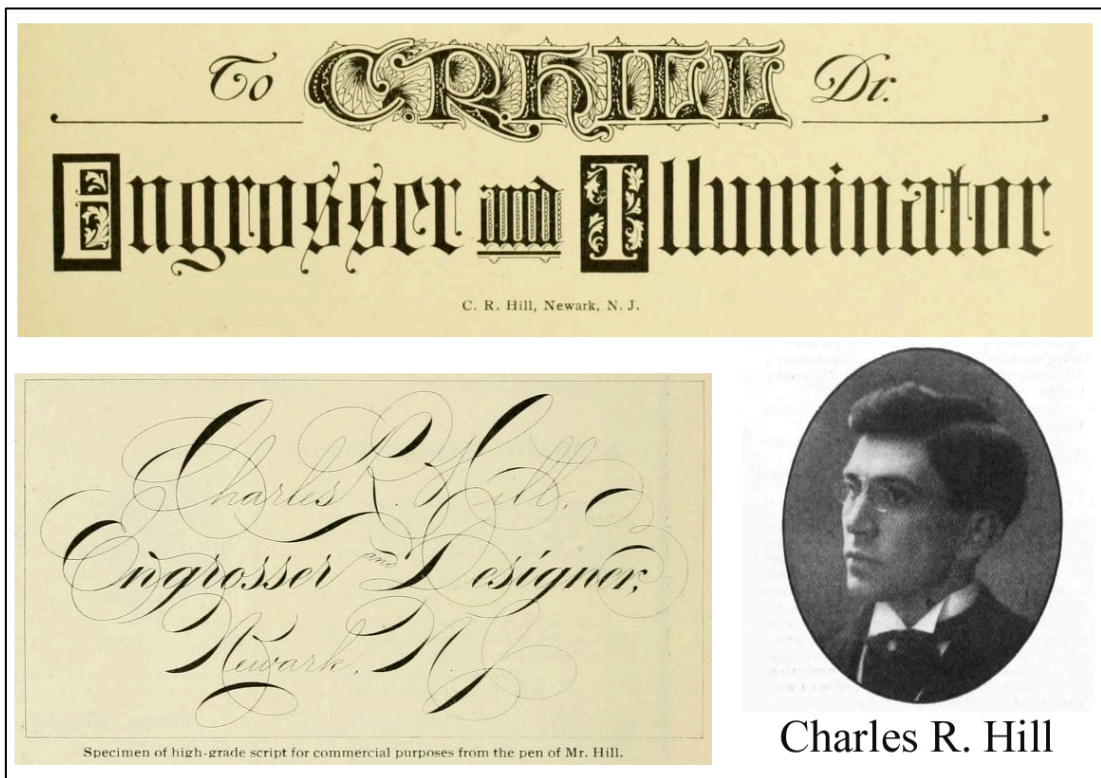

#### MR. CHARLES R. HILL

Mr. Charles R. Hill recently was appointed instructor in penmanship in the Bay Path Institute, Springfield, Massachusetts. Mr. Hill has a wide experience in education and business as a student, instructor and business executive.

Since receiving his B. C. S. Degree from New York University in 1923, he has held the positions of editor, sales and advertising manager for the Ellis Publishing Company, Battle Creek, Michigan; chairman of the Commercial Teacher Training department of the Northern State Teachers College, Aberdeen, South Dakota; and also Western Manager of the secondary textbook department of Prentice Hall, Inc.

In addition he is the co-author of two commercial text books.

Mr. Hill is one of the finest penmen and engrossers in the United States. Some of his work hangs on the walls of the Zanerian College along with the work of other famous penmen. Mr. Hill received much of his training and penmanship inspiration from the founder of The Educator—Mr. C. P. Zaner.

Mr. C. R. Hill, was born at Conestoga, Pa., April 14, 1886. He is of German descent, and after completing the work in the public

schools and high school of his home town, he attended the First Pennsylvania State Normal School, Millersville, Pa. At this time he came under the able instruction and inspiration of Mr. E. W. Strickler, the penman, after which he attended the Zanerian.

He is now head of the penmanship department of the Bowling Green, Ky., Business University.

No one in our profession is forging more rapidly toward the forefront than Mr. Hill. The work he is contributing from time to time to THE BUSINESS EDUCATOR displays unusual industry and far more talent than is common. If Mr. Hill continues as he has begun he will some day be a leader in our profession.

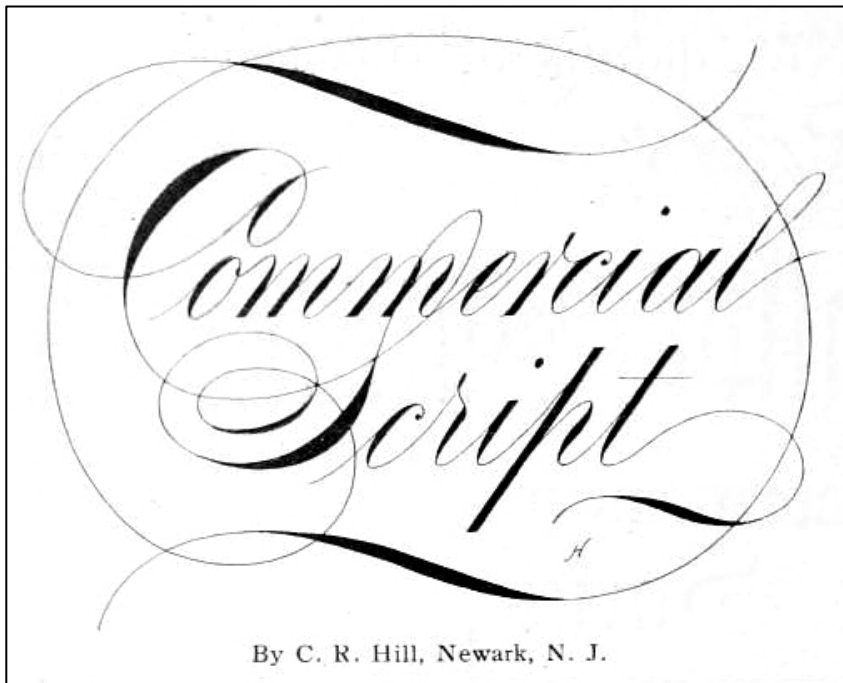

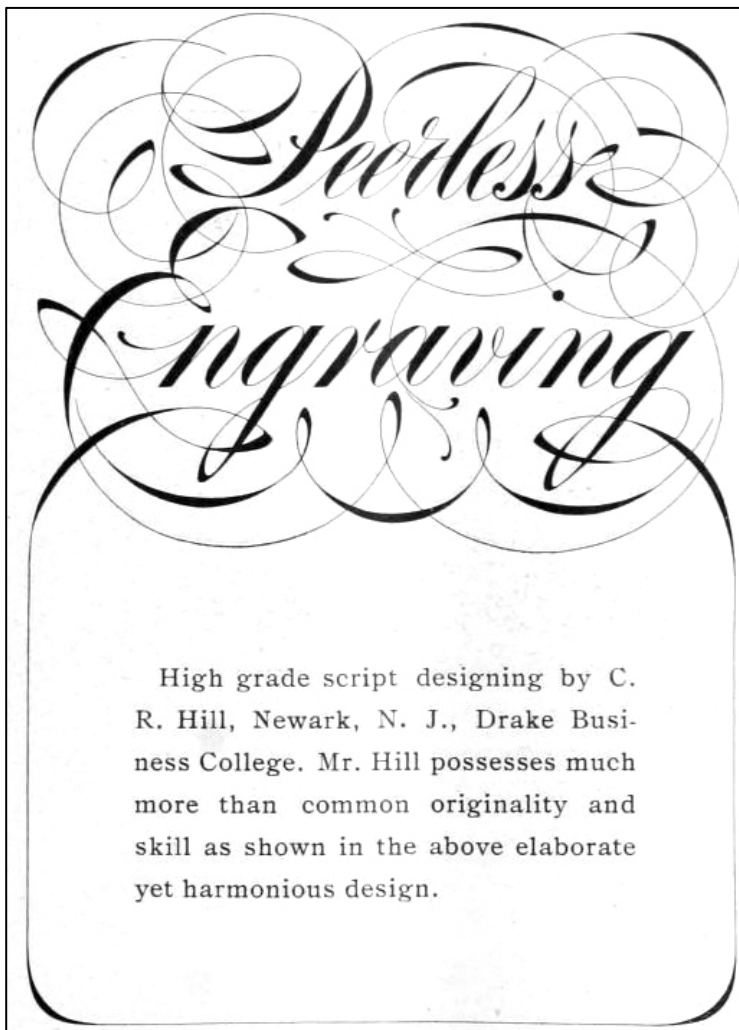

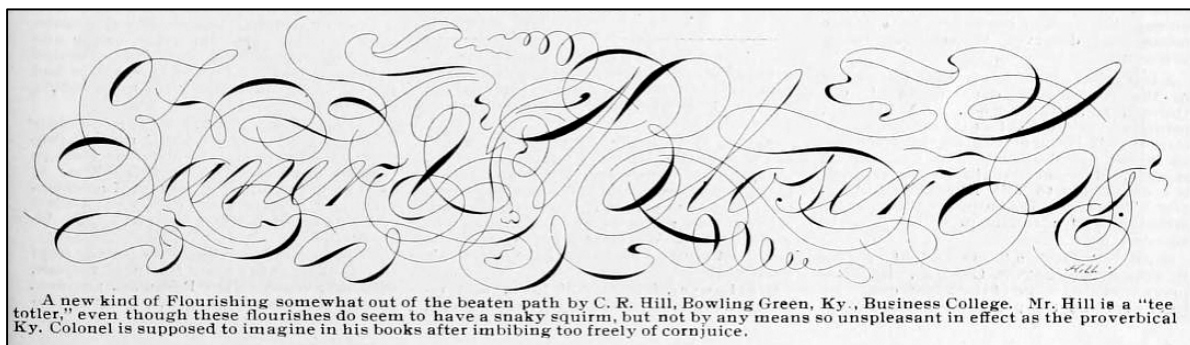
